Product Description

Sentinel RMS is a software licensing SDK for your applications. It increases revenue by authorizing the use of your applications and offers a variety of licensing schemes to boost your product sales. It also provides tools that system administrators can use to track and manage licenses in a network.

When SCL add-on is combined with the license enforcement features of Sentinel RMS and the entitlement management features of Sentinel EMS, it makes a complete solution that provides the benefits of cloud-connected licensing to applications deployed in the customer's network or hosted online. Usage collection and reporting is the most significant advantage obtained with cloud-connected licensing.

About This Document

This document contains details about the new features, problems corrected, and installation of the v9.4.0 of the Sentinel RMS SDK. The last major release was Sentinel RMS v9.3.0.

New Features and Enhancements

This section lists the new features and enhancements included in Sentinel RMS SDK v9.4.0 release.

Cancel Active Lease or Resume Lease

In this release, we have introduced two new functionalities, Cancel Lease and Resume Lease respectively. They are discussed in detail in the following sub-sections.



Note: Currently, we have provide these functionalities for cloud-served lease standalone license deployment mode only.

Cancel Lease

Some of the main features are as follows:

- Cancel Lease enables an end user to return the active lease license and free up the license on Sentinel cloud so that it can be provided to other end users.
- After cancelation, the lease will not be renewed even if the enforcement application or machine is restarted.
- The cancel operation acts on the complete machine. After the latest lease is returned, old lease licenses on the machine will stop working.
- Post cancelation, all application installed on the machine will not be able to use the lease license. Further, the lease will be unusable from other apps only after force sync, auto sync, or app-context new.
- The lease thread is suspended and SCP will not connect to cloud for a lease license.
- Cancel lease action suspends the lease sync activity for the complete device.



Note: Cancel lease requires connectivity with cloud back end operations in order to be successfully executed. If the machine develops a hardware failure and cannot connect with the back end, then the ISV's end customers may contact; and on trust basis the ISV may use Complete Revoke (on EMS GUI) or mark Revoke REST WS (on active activations) for the desired customer machine.



Note: For cancel lease, 'Allow Revocation' flag should be set as true while creating the entitlement in EMS.

Enhancement in the `sntl_licensing_transfer API`

A new action (`<cancelLease></cancelLease>`) has been introduced to support this functionality.

This action does not require any input parameter.

Resume Lease

Some of the main features are as follows:

- Resume Lease is used to undo the effect of the cancel lease operation.
- After canceling a lease license, if a user wants to use the lease license, then they must resume the lease.
- The lease thread will be activated and SCP will connect to cloud to provide a lease license to the user.



Note: When the resume lease is called, it will bring licenses only if the quantity is available.



Note: Standalone persistence must be initialize before performing cancel and resume lease operations.

Enhancement in the `sntl_licensing_transfer API`

A new action (`<resumeLease></resumeLease>`) has been introduced to support this functionality.

This action does not require any input parameter.

Installation Information

This section contains important information related to the installation of Sentinel RMS SDK.

Before installing the Sentinel RMS SDK, ensure that you have the following:

- Administrator Privileges: You must have administrator privileges to successfully install all the components.
- Sentinel RMS SDK Serial Number: You require a valid serial number provided by Gemalto. The installer prompts you to enter the serial number provided to you.

Installation Instructions

1. Double-click *StartHere.exe* from the root of the installation media. The Start Here screen appears.
2. Click **Install under Sentinel RMS Development Kit 9.4.0 Software**. The Welcome screen appears.



Note: If you are installing the RMS SDK using the steps described here, you need not click the **Install** option under Sentinel RMS License Manager Installer. This option is for only installing the Sentinel RMS License Manager, which is automatically installed as a part of the SDK on your system.

3. Click **Next**. A screen showing the license agreement appears.
4. To proceed, accept the license agreement and click **Next**.
5. In the Customer Information dialog box, type your name, organization name, and the RMS SDK serial number. This serial number is contained in the Gemalto Sentinel Order Credential e-mail and is unique to each vendor.
6. You may modify the SDK installation directory. The default installation directory is:
 - On 32-bit machines - <OSdrive>:\Program Files\SafeNet Sentinel\Sentinel RMS Development Kit\<version>\
 - On 64-bit machines - <OSdrive>:\Program Files (x86)\SafeNet Sentinel\Sentinel RMS Development Kit\<version>\
7. Select the **Complete** or **Custom** installation option.




Note: The Custom installation option for the RMS SDK cannot be used on non-English operating systems.

8. You are prompted for modifying the system firewall settings. Choose between the following options:
 - Select the check box to allow communication with the License Manager. This setting adds the License Manager to your system firewall's exceptions list.
 - Clear the check box to block communication with the License Manager (not recommended).
9. Follow the on-screen instructions to finish the installation.

Installed Directories

Development	Contains all the RMS libraries, header files, XSDs and source code for licensing and customization.
Manuals	Contains the various documentation items for Sentinel RMS.
Redistributable	Contains the utilities and files for your customers, including the Sentinel RMS License Manager installer.
Samples	Contains the sample programs for demonstrating the use of various RMS features and API.
VendorTools	Contains the utilities and files for your use.  Note: The license generator is no longer included with the SDK. The order e-mail contains a link that enables you to download the license generator.
install.rbo	Contains information about the Sentinel RMS SDK version and serial number.
ReleaseNotes	This file.
